The mission of Habitat for Humanity of Sangamon County (HFHSC) is to create and sustain simple, decent and affordable housing in partnership with the community for all God's people in need.

Since 1989, HFHSC has helped over 650 individuals escape poverty housing, which we define as housing that is overcrowded, unsafe, unsanitary, or when more than 30% of the family's monthly income is spent on housing.

Funding for HFHSC operations comes from individual and corporate donations, as well as profits from the ReStore. Volunteers help keep operating costs to a minimum and allow more of the donations to go towards direct services for our Partner Families.

HFHSC has constructed 107 homes, as of November 2017, throughout Sangamon County and looks forward to continuing to partner with the community to eliminate poverty housing.

HFHSC fulfills its mission through the following programs:

New Home Construction/Home Renovation

Working, low-income families with AMI below 80% purchase a home built or renovated by volunteers through a no interest, full amortized home mortgage. This affordable payment also includes real estate taxes and home insurance.

Handicap Ramp Installations

Low-income homeowners pay for the materials and volunteers design and install a handicap ramp that is compliant with city codes.
